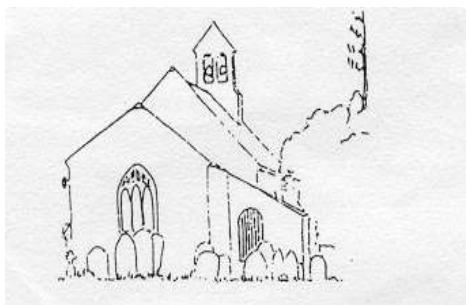

A MESSAGE FROM THE BISHOP OF WHITBY

Bishop Paul Ferguson has written to the Churchwardens as follows:

The Bishop of Whitby wishes to inform you of the appointment of the Reverend Helen Rawlings as Assistant Curate (House for Duty Deacon) of the Plurality of Helmsley and Upper Ryedale parishes.

The Reverend Helen Rawlings was ordained deacon in the Diocese of Chichester in 2013.

Before ordination, Helen spent time working for Sussex police in various roles including Community Beat Manager, Tutor, Sexual Offences Liaison Officer and Family Liaison Officer. Following ordination as a Deacon Helen was appointed Assistant Curate in the Parish of The Good Shepherd, Preston, Brighton. Additionally, she also holds the office of Mission Port Officer for her local Fishermen's Mission. Helen is the UK Coordinator for Hellen's Shelter, a place of refuge for street children in Lira, Uganda.

Helen is also a trained artist illustrator, mostly of wildlife and animal portraits, but also using images and creative activities in her ministry. She enjoys gardening, travel and arts more widely.

Helen will be moving in due course into Old Byland Rectory. The service to mark the beginning of her ministry in the plurality will be held at a later date and arrangements will be announced shortly.

A personal message from me: 'Helen has a deep love of God and his people. I am delighted that she is joining us in the Cleveland Archdeaconry. I am sure that the people of the parishes will enjoy getting to know her and working with her.'
