All Saints Church Helmsley is 150 years old!

This month we celebrate the 150th anniversary of the rebuilding of Helmsley Church in 1868. We do not know what the Victorians chose to rebuild the medieval church which had been on the present site from at least 1129. Perhaps this doesn't matter - we are now the keepers of a very fine building - many say that its feel is that of a small cathedral.

We are marking this special year in two ways. First, a 24hr 'hymnathon' Saturday 16 - Sunday 17 June, 10am - 10am. We hope you will choose your favourite hymn(s) to be played or sung, and it maybe that you would like to come and sing or play a hymn special to you!
