The Revd Helen Rawlings writes

Dear Friends

Tempus fugit as they say and time certainly seems to be going by quickly - we are no sooner getting over the excesses of Christmas puddings and cakes, than we are looking forward to Easter, with chocolate eggs and more cake.

Before Easter, of course, we have Lent, a time of waiting and preparation; its purpose to lead us to the feast of Easter. In a similar way to Advent, when we waited and prepared for the birth of new life in Jesus at Christmas, we wait in Lent for new life in the resurrection, after Jesus' death on the cross, and the promise of eternal life for us all. This is why for both these periods of waiting the liturgical colour is the same –purple.

As part of that preparation Lent was traditionally a time of fasting, mirroring the 40 days and nights Jesus spent in the desert, and very few of us actually fast anymore, many do make an effort to 'give something up'; chocolate springs to mind. I wonder how many people appreciate why they are really 'giving up chocolate for Lent', that what we give up is less important than taking stock and getting our priorities in order,

ready for the Christian Year's greatest celebration at Easter. Perhaps, instead, we should be thinking of a way we can 'give to' instead of 'giving up' something for Lent; by giving to a charitable cause or in some way helping others would be a far better way of following God's call and preparing ourselves for his coming at Easter.

Unfortunately, due to unforeseen circumstances we will have to cancel both the meeting on 19th March and the visit to the National Gallery on 9th April but hopefully will be able make that trip later in the year.

Instead we will meet at the Rectory on 9th April for our last evening together to have a bring and share supper.

You are welcome to come along to any one or all of the Lent groups where we will be looking at some paintings by the great masters and at how they interpret the scriptures.

One theologian maintained that "a great painting can affirm the goodness of God's creation and point to God the creator." Another that "theology cannot be complete until it appropriates the non-verbal 'arts' otherwise we limit the capacity of the arts to be used by God in his revelation".

Art has been used to convey religious themes in one form or another since man first held a tool in his hands. Because we are all so different, art speaks to some more than others and often at different stages of our life journey. So if it has not yet been part of your journey I do hope you will come and join these sessions and give it a try.
