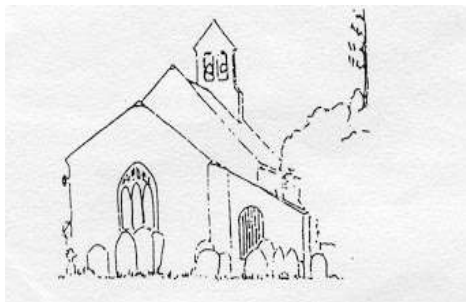

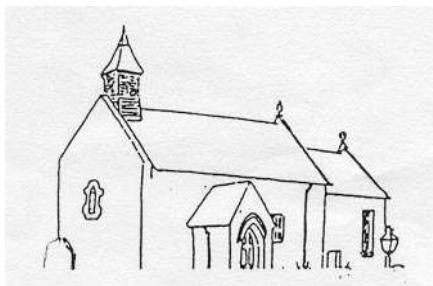

## **The Revd Helen Rawlings writes**

Dear Friends

November is a time for remembering; and for taking stock and making sure we are prepared for the winter weather ahead – (that reminds me I must make sure I have enough oil in my tank!)

Starting with 1<sup>st</sup>, we have All Saints Day, then on 2<sup>nd</sup> November we think of all our lost loved ones on All Souls Day; we normally do this at church on the nearest Sunday which this year is 4<sup>th</sup> with our service at St. John's Bilsdale at 3.00pm in the afternoon. All are welcome to come and light a candle for anyone they would like to remember.

11<sup>th</sup> November is of course Armistice Day, which this year as everyone will know, is the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the original armistice, so as well as a time to remember those who have lost their lives in the service of their country in all wars, this year will be a special celebration to mark the end of that terrible World War which at the time was hoped to be the war to end all wars. Our Remembrance Service for Upper Ryedale will be at Hawaby and will start at 10.30 instead of the usual 10.00am so that we can have the 2 minutes silence at 11.00. Please do come and if you can, especially if you know anyone involved in, or affected by, combat at any time. This year, to mark the centenary a call has gone out for church bells all up and down the country to be rung during the day (after 11.00 am) and Helmsley church will be ringing a peal with their eight bells... our own churches in Upper Ryland with only one or two bells each may not be able to manage a full peal but will certainly be rung, so do listen out for them.

In 2012 I was lucky enough to go on a trip with ToCH to Talbot House in Poperinge near Ypres. The house is kept almost as it was during WW1 when it served as a club for all soldiers. A sign at the door read "abandon rank all ye who enter here" and it was the only place (and probably still is) where an officer could be found playing a game of chess with a private soldier. The attic chapel is particularly moving; a place where many took their first – and their last – communion. I will speak more about my visit at our Remembrance service.
