## **Cold Kirby Village Hall**

The hall Committee have been sending out an email newsletter to keep local people informed and I reproduce part of it here.

Since the last note on 15 August, according to the Government's figures the number of Covid 19 cases in North Yorkshire generally has continued to increase and at a slightly faster rate with 110 new cases in the county. On this side of the county however the increases have been much less significant, with just 3 new cases in Ryedale, 9 in Scarborough and 17 in Hambleton. Over the same period there have been 23 new cases in York. So the infection rates here continue to be much lower than the national average, which is of course heavily influenced by the "hotspots" in other parts of the country. And across the piece, as has been widely reported, the rates of admission to hospitals are much lower than in the earlier stages of the pandemic, which has got to be good news.
